Located in Kennebunk’s historic Lafayette Center, Duffy’s serves a full lunch and dinner daily, as well as breakfast on Sundays. The space, complete with exposed beams and large windows overlooking the Mousam River and Mousam River Dam, exudes a raw mill feel while providing 21st century comforts.
